

HOW THE BELIEVER IS DEAD TO THE LAW Romans 7:4

Jesus is humanity's God given substitute for Adam. Romans 5:18

Because of His sinless death, Jesus has the right as a Man to remove all sin and death from creation. Romans 8:3 John 5:27

Jesus is in the process of redeeming all creation. Romans 8:21

Jesus is the believer's replacement for Adam. Romans 5:15-18

The believer died to sin (Rom. 6:2), died to the law (Rom. 7:6), and is a new creation no longer in dominating relationship to Adam. The believer has a new relationship with the New Adam, Jesus Christ. Believers are delivered from bondage to sin. Through the power of the indwelling Holy Spirit, believers do not have to sin. Believers are delivered from the law and its condemnation and are united to Christ (Rom. 8:1,2). Believers are united to Christ for the purpose of bringing forth fruit unto God (Rom. 7:4).

Believers do righteous actions initiated and led by the indwelling Spirit. Rom. 8:13-16,26-27

Believers are in the process of sin removal throughout life through the disciplinary work of God. 1 Corinthians 11:31,32 Hebrews 12:5-8

Righteous actions are the record of the believer beginning at regeneration and rewarded at Judgment. Revelation 19:8 Philippians 1:6 1 Corinthians 3:9-15

At physical death, believers enter the presence of Jesus free of the sin nature and holy in His sight. Ephesians 1:3-14

Free from the law means that believers are not living by focus on the law. Believers live by focusing on Jesus and letting Him rule from the heart. Galatians 5:18-26

Believers should live out of a loving heart with an attitude produced by the Spirit. This attitude is of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. This attitude should rule the life of the believer rather than a set of laws and regulations.

Because of the present living Christ in the believer, any righteous act empowered by the Holy Spirit is a fruit which glorifies God. Any right attitude or right action is a fruit unto God.
