

BABIES ARE SAFE IN JESUS

All babies, except Jesus, are born with a sin nature having a tendency toward sin and an ultimate fulfillment of sin and guilt.

All accountable people are convicted of sin, judgment, and the need for right standing with God. When a person rejects that conviction of the Holy Spirit, he is condemned for his unwillingness to cooperate with conviction leading to repentance, and leading to belief in Jesus for sin removal. Continuation in this Holy Spirit rejection is the only sin which results in condemnation and eternal separation from God. Babies cannot commit this sin. Matthew 12:31

Because Jesus defeated sin, death, and Satan by His physical death on the cross, all people are provisionally reconciled to God and their sins are not counted against them. 2 Corinthians 5:19

Because of the sinless death of Jesus, because of the condemnation of sin by His sinless and unjust death, because God freely forgives sin, and because babies cannot be condemned for unbelief, babies are safe in Jesus. John 3:18,36 Romans 8:3

“Condemnation of sin in the flesh” means that sin is condemned to its ultimate destruction. Sin, death, and all evil will be removed from creation by Jesus Christ who is given all power and authority to judge all things. Romans 8:3 John 5:22 Matthew 28:18

God freely forgives sin but there is a specific condition for provisional, judicial, and parental forgiveness.

Jesus' sinless death was the condition for our provisional forgiveness. 2 Cor. 5:19

Romans 5:10 When we were enemies, we were provisionally reconciled to God by the death of His Son, much more, being judicially reconciled by faith we shall be saved by His life.

Saving faith and new birth is the condition for our judicial forgiveness. John 3:16

Romans 5:1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Confession and repentance is the condition for our parental forgiveness. 1 John 1:9
