

WHAT IS THE FOUNDATION OF YOUR HOPE?

Jesus promises to take away your sins and make you righteous and fit for Heaven. You can be neither free of sins nor fully righteous in practice except you escape your sin nature. You can not be free of your sin nature except you be free of your present physical body. Being fit for Heaven is a process which Jesus promises to accomplish in you, the believer, at some point in the future. Salvation encompasses all of this future deliverance.

God is justified in saving believers because Jesus has gained the right at the cross to deliver you from sin.

God condemned sin when sinless Jesus died, and God gave Jesus all authority to remove sin from creation because of His sinless death.

Believers are in a process called “sanctification” as they live “in Christ” and begin to experience deliverance.

At physical death, believers are removed from their sin nature and enter Heaven totally sinless and totally righteous. Their righteousness was produced by Jesus Christ while living “in Christ.”

At the Rapture, believers receive glorified bodies adaptable for both Heaven and Earth.

Romans 7:18 Nothing good lives in my sin nature.

Romans 7:24 Jesus Christ will rescue believers from this body of death (our sin nature).

Romans 8:12 Believers have an obligation to not be controlled by their sin nature.

Romans 8:16,17 The Holy Spirit shows believers that they are children of God as we share in His sufferings.

Romans 8:17 Believers are promised to share in the glory of Christ as heirs of God and of Christ.

Romans 8:26-27 The Holy Spirit intercedes to help believers even helping us to pray.

John 14:3 I will come back and take you to be with Me. 14:6 I Am the Way, the Truth, and the Life.

1 Thess. 5:9 God did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to receive salvation through Jesus.

Revelation 21:8 To be saved is to have all sin removed escaping the second death.

Revelation 19:8 To be saved is to be made new with righteous acts performed by Christ in us.

1 Thess. 4:7 God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life.

1 Thess. 4:16-17 Christ will return and gather all saints in glorified bodies to meet Him in the air.

JESUS CHRIST IS YOUR SURE FOUNDATION

Being man and God, Jesus died a physical death and a sinless death giving Him justification for removing sin and death from all creation. Jesus condemned sin by the death of His sinless flesh and blood.

Romans 8:3

Being God and being man, Jesus has the power to remove all sin and death from creation. His power is the same resurrection power that allowed Him to rise from the grave and ascend to the Father.

Being the Son of God, Jesus has been given, by God the Father, all authority to judge all of creation and restore it to a sinless and deathless eternal condition. John 5:22 Matthew 28:18

By His resurrection life, Jesus has the power to remove you personally from sins power and dominion. To receive His deliverance, believe and receive His free gift of eternal life in Him.

Your justification for eternal life comes by the new life of Jesus in you. The one condition upon you is to believe Jesus and receive Jesus as Lord and Savior. Jesus has done all that is necessary for you to have life in Him, and He will continue to accomplish it when you receive His free gift.
