

GOD LAID OUR SINS ON JESUS WHICH WAS MORE THAN HIS PHYSICAL BODY COULD BEAR

Jesus grew in wisdom and stature. So Jesus was not omniscient. Even toward the end of His three year ministry, Jesus declared that the angels did not know when His Second Coming would be. Jesus stated that He did not know, and that only the Father knew (Mark 13:32).

Jesus ministered for three years in total submission and dependence on the Father much in the way we should do ministry. In the same way Jesus experienced the Cross with complete trust in the Word of God, having perfect faith, and perfect obedience. Jesus is the only perfect man because Jesus is God in the flesh. But God in the flesh laid aside some of His privileges including omniscience. Philippians 2:7,8

On the Cross from noon until three o'clock, Jesus was given omniscience of all humanities sins. The Father laid on Jesus more than His physical body could bear. By His knowledge, Jesus bore all our iniquities experiencing the physical, emotional, and mental anguish of all sin being against God. Isaiah 53:11

At the Cross, God condemned sin to the utmost. Matthew 21:33-46 Romans 8:3

Jesus remained obedient even to physical death, always trusting in the Father to fulfill all Scripture and bring about the complete and final condemnation of sin. Because Jesus, the perfect man, died sinless under the very wrath of sin against Him, the Father has given resurrected Jesus the authority to remove all sin from Creation (Colossians 1:20; John 5:22,27; Matthew 28:18).

Jesus has the right as last Adam to remove sin from all who believe in Him and receive Him as LORD and Savior. Sin removal is a process including sanctification and glorification. Sin has eternal consequences for believers and holy living requires Holy Spirit guidance and power.
