Isaiah 53:11 People who cooperate with the Holy Spirit, believe in Jesus to fulfill God's promises, and receive spiritual birth, will be saved from their sins.

"Jesus took our blame" means that Jesus took our abuse toward Him and suffered our abuse against Him on the Cross. It does not mean that God the Father punished Jesus in our place.

Jesus Himself bore our sins in His body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by His wounds you have been healed. 1 Peter 2:24

"Jesus bore our sins" means that Jesus took our abuse toward Him and suffered our abuse.
