

## THE FATHER THAT WE NEED TO KNOW

**Misleading Statement:** Your sin is so serious, God killed His Son (Jesus) because of it. God poured out His wrath on Jesus. God punished Jesus for your sin so that He would not have to punish you.

No where in Scripture does God the Father describe the Cross of Jesus as Him pouring out His wrath on Jesus, or as Him punishing Jesus for our sin.

Scripture says that Jesus gave Himself for sins condemnation (1 Timothy 2:6 Romans 8:3). Scripture says: the Father was pleased to allow His Son to be bruised as an offering for sin so that sin may be condemned (Isaiah 53:10), our sin was laid upon Him and our sins killed Him (Isaiah 53:4-6 Acts 3:15 Genesis 3:15), and by His knowledge and His experience on the cross Jesus bore our sins (Isaiah 53:11).

Jesus gave Himself a ransom for all. 1 Timothy 2:6 John 10:18

God sent His Son to condemn sin (Romans 8:3) triumphing over all powers at the Cross (Col. 2:15).

It pleased the LORD to bruise Him making His soul an offering for sin. Isaiah 53:10

God allowed Jesus to be bruised and die. Genesis 3:15 Acts 3:14-15; 2:23 1 Thess. 2:15

Men thought Jesus was stricken, smitten of God (Isaiah 53:4), but He was wounded because of our sins (Isaiah 53:5), crushed because of our sins, His learning obedience was for our peace, and by His stripes we are healed. Even though Jesus was God's Son He learned obedience from the things He suffered ( Hebrews 5:8).

And the LORD laid on Him the iniquity of us all. Isaiah 53:6

By His knowledge He shall bear our iniquities. Isaiah 53:11

Satan will bruise the heel of Jesus, but Jesus will bruise Satan's head. Genesis 3:15

You denied the Holy One and the Just, and you killed the Prince of life, whom God hath raised from the dead (Acts 3:14-15).

When Jesus sees all that is accomplished by His anguish, He will be satisfied. And because of His experience, my righteous servant will make it possible for many to be counted righteous, for He will bear all their sins. Isaiah 53:11 NLT

The experience in which Jesus bore all our sins is when the Father gave Jesus all knowledge of personal sins of all people of all time. Jesus saw my sin. All our sins were laid on Jesus. Jesus died because of the burden of all our sins. But His sinless death condemned sin to the utmost, and Jesus arose with authority to remove all sin from all those who believe in Him.
