

DOCUMENTATION FOR THE GOSPEL OF JESUS CHRIST

Jesus died sinless so that He has the right to remove all sin from creation. John 1:29; 5:22

Jesus died sinless so that He has the right to remove all sin for those who believe in Him. 1 John 3:5

Jesus arose and ascended so that we know that He can save us by His life. Acts 1:1-11

Jesus' death was the prerequisite for redemption and we are saved by His life. Romans 5:8-10

The Way by which we are saved is to cooperate with the Holy Spirit and be brought to believe that

Jesus can and will save us from our sin. John 14:6; 16:8-16 Romans 10:13

When we believe, we die to sin (our sole relationship to Adam) and we are born again of the Spirit to a new relationship with Jesus, our Second and Last Adam. My security of salvation is based on His promise. We are saved by His resurrection life in us. To be saved is to be changed. We are being changed into His likeness. We will be glorified at the resurrection.

Believers are "in Christ." Believers are justified in having eternal life because Jesus is making us new and will make us completely sinless and completely righteous. There is no penalty for sinlessness and righteousness. Believers are sanctified (set apart for service and purpose) and are being sanctified (changed to be like Christ). Romans chapter 3-8

Jesus died for the whole world. Jesus' sinless death gives Him the right to save you from sin for all who cooperate with the Spirit and believe. God is justified in saving those who believe because of the change in the believer to a new creation. God the Father has given Jesus all authority, power, and judgment over creation because of His special sinless death and His resurrection. Jesus' death was the holy, sinless, sacrifice for sin's condemnation and ultimate removal.

All accountable people have the need to cooperate with Holy Spirit conviction and receive the gift of salvation by calling upon the name of Jesus. Romans 10:9-13 John 16:8

The one condition for receiving salvation is to cooperate with Holy Spirit conviction and believe in the Lord Jesus Christ Acts 16:31

Jesus saves believers from the penalty of sin by giving them a new birth and by making them a new creation. Believers can know that they have a

relationship with Jesus Christ and eternal life. 1 John 5:13
