

GOSPEL OF JESUS CHRIST

John 1:29 Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away all sin from the cosmos “creation.”

Jesus arose from the dead:

Matthew 28:18 With all power and authority. **Colossians 2:15** Triumphant over Satan and all powers and authorities. **John 5:22** Having been given all judgment over heaven and earth.

Romans 5:10 And is saving believers by His resurrection life.

Looking back to the Cross of Jesus let's see why the Cross and the Lamb take sin away.

Sin can do almost anything and rationalize itself or justify itself. There is one thing sin cannot do and rationalize it or justify it. Sin cannot kill a holy, sinless, and innocent man without condemning itself. Satan did not see this coming or he would have tried to stop Jesus from dying.

Romans 8:3 God sent Jesus to die a special death that would condemn sin to the utmost.

At the Cross, sin condemned itself by killing the holy, sinless, physical body of the Son of God.

1 Peter 1:19 God sentenced sin to removal from all creation. **Daniel 9:24**

Total removal of sin will be carried out at the Great White Throne Judgment. **Rev. 20:11-15**

The delay is to give opportunity for sinners to cooperate with the Holy Spirit, receive the gift of eternal life, and have their sin removed.

God is justified in saving believers because He makes them “literally” righteous and He “literally” takes away their sin as a result of their faith in Jesus. **Romans 3:21-26**

IT IS PERFECT JUSTICE FOR GOD TO SAVE THE RIGHTEOUS AND THE SINLESS.

All who are “in Christ” are new creations. **2 Corinthians 5:17**

All those who have received the gift of eternal life are being made into the image of Jesus.

Romans 8:9

Jesus was the sacrifice for sin. He was the sin offering in which our guilt and condemnation can be removed through our faith in Jesus' willingness and ability to take away our sin.

Isaiah 53:10

JESUS' SPECIAL DEATH

Romans 8:3 God sent Jesus to die a special death that would condemn sin to the utmost resulting in all sin being taken away by the power of His death and resurrection. The Cross of Jesus condemns sin to its utter removal from creation.

Jesus' special death:

1 Peter 1:19 Jesus lived and died sinless. Our sin killed the holy and sinless Son of God.

1 Peter 2:24 All our sin came against Jesus, nailing Him to the Cross, causing Him great anguish even unto death.

Isaiah 53:11 By His knowledge all our sin was laid on Him.

SIN WAS CONDEMNED AT THE CROSS AND SENTENCED TO REMOVAL FROM CREATION

Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy. Daniel 9:24
