

## SCRIPTURE INTERPRETS SCRIPTURE

The following is an interpretation of Isaiah 53 according to New Testament doctrine.

Jesus learned obedience by the things He suffered. Hebrews 5:8

Jesus offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto Him who was able to save Him from death and He was heard because of His reverent and obedient submission. Hebrews 5:7

And God raised Him from the dead. Acts 13:30

The discipline of our peace was upon Him. Isaiah 53:5c

The LORD laid on Him the iniquity of us all. Isaiah 53:6c

By His knowledge, He shall bear their iniquities. Isaiah 53:11b

Jesus became the sin offering and no sin was found in Him. 2 Corinthians 5:21a

After He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, He sat down on the right hand of God. Hebrews 10:12

But now once in the end of the age has He appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. Hebrews 9:26b

It pleased the LORD to allow Him to be bruised. He put Him to grief. His soul is made a sin offering. He shall see His seed. He shall prolong His days. The pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand. Isaiah 53:10

God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself. 2 Corinthians 5:19a

God sent His Son to condemn sin. Romans 8:3a

Come let us kill Him, and they cast Him out of the vineyard and killed Him.

Matthew 21:38,39

**Peter said, “You men of Israel, you denied the Holy One and the Just, and killed the Prince of life, whom God raised from the dead.” Acts 3:14-15**

**God said, “You (Satan) shall bruise His heel, but He shall bruise your head.”**

**Genesis 3:15**

**At about three o’clock, Jesus cried out with a loud voice, “My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken Me?” Matthew 27:46**

**At three o’clock, the curtain in the sanctuary was torn down the middle. Then Jesus called out in a loud voice, “Father, into Your hands I commit My Spirit.”**

**Luke 23:44-46**

**For God has not ignored His affliction, neither has He hid His face from Him, but when He cried unto Him, He heard. Psalm 22:24**

**By the one righteous act of Jesus, the free gift came upon all men resulting in the justification of life. Romans 5:18b**

**By the obedience of One shall many be made righteous. Romans 5:19b**

**As many as had readiness of mind to believe, they received eternal life.**

**Acts 13:48**

**And if the house be worthy (with readiness of mind to believe), let your peace come upon it. Matthew 10:13a**

**For whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. Romans 10:13**

**For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. Romans 10:10**

**So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. Romans 10:17**

**Before the foundation of the world, God has chosen that those who are “in Christ” will be made holy and blameless before Him in love. Ephesians 1:4**

**God predestined us who are “in Christ” for divine adoption as sons to Himself through Jesus Christ, according to the good pleasure of His will. Ephesians 1:5**

**God predestined us who are “in Christ” to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. Romans 8:29**

**Those who are “in Christ” are called according to His purpose. Romans 8:28**

**For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them. Ephesians 2:10**

**For those “in Christ” which He predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, He also called to good works, and those He called He justified by declaring them “new creations”, and He also glorified by promising to complete His work in them. Romans 8:30**

**Jesus gave Himself as a ransom for all, to purchase freedom for everyone. This is the message God gave to the world at just the right time. 1 Timothy 2:6**

**Jesus is the sacrifice that takes away our sins, and not only for ours, but also for those of the whole world. 1 John 2:2**

**There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus.**

**Romans 8:1**

**Comparing Isaiah 53 with New Testament Scripture we find that the sinless life and sinless death of Jesus gained Him the right to remove sin from all creation.**

**Sin is condemned because sin killed a sinless Man (Romans 8:3). Sin is sentenced to removal from all creation. Sin removal is in process for all those who put their faith in Jesus. Jesus has been declared Judge over all Heaven and Earth. Sin will ultimately be judged and removed from all Heaven and Earth. Thus death will be removed.**

**Jesus gained the right to make new creations of all those who cooperate and have a readiness of mind to receive Christ and be changed. Christ saves us by His resurrection life lived out in us producing His righteousness in our daily living. So our salvation is all about our new life in Him. The choice of man is to receive eternal life in Christ or perish (John 3:16).**

**The only Way for the wrath of God to be averted by man is for the man to be changed through new birth in Christ. The change is completed through glorification.**

**The Bible does not teach that the wrath of God is averted by God killing Jesus in our place to appease His wrath. There are many false phrases being used which are not from the Bible and describe a false Jesus. Jesus did not die to change God. Jesus died to condemn sin and gain the right to change those who receive Him.**
