

## JESUS' LIFE OF HUMBLE SERVICE

**Philippians 2:8b He humbled Himself and became obedient to death, even death on a cross!**

**(1) Jesus' obedience unto death defeated sin.**

**John 1:29 Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.**

**(2) Jesus' authority brings judgments for sin removal.**

**John 13:3 Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He was come from God, and went to God;**

**John 5:22 Moreover, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment to the Son, that all may honor the Son just as they honor the Father.**

**(3) Jesus' resurrection proves His right to remove sin.**

**Jesus' resurrection proved His right as Man, Second Adam to judge and remove sin from creation.**

**Jesus was victorious over sin and death. By killing the sinless Son of God, sin proved itself to be the atrocious enemy of life that it had always been. Jesus arose with all power and authority at His disposal. Jesus is presently reconciling men to God by making those who believe and receive Him into new creations.**

**(4) Believing in Jesus for sin removal yields new birth.**

**The one who believes in Jesus is moved out from under God's wrath.**

**John 3:36 Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life for God's wrath remains on him.**

**Jesus taught the disciples about the washing of regeneration by washing their feet.**

**Read John 13:3-10**

**(5) Washing of regeneration yields works of righteousness and a daily walk in power and purity.**

**John 13:8 Peter, at first, did not want Jesus to wash his feet.**

**Peter learned that to be in relationship with Jesus is to daily walk in the power and purity of Christ.**

**The washing of regeneration (new birth) is the way we begin our new life in Christ. When we believe Jesus and receive Him as Savior and Lord, He gives us the washing of regeneration.**

**Titus 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Spirit. We take our place with Him at the cross, dying to self, and living according to His acts of righteousness.**

**For those who believe in Jesus and are being made new creations, they clothe themselves in fine linen, bright and clean, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. Revelation 19:8**

**Acts of righteousness assigned to the new creation include:**

**Love one another, serve one another, encourage one another, build each other up in Christ, live in peace with each other, be patient with everyone, be kind to all, be joyful, pray continually, give thanks in all things, don't quench or grieve the Spirit, hold on to what is good, avoid every kind of evil.**

**1 Thessalonians 5:12-24**

**John 13:14 If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; you also ought to wash one another's feet.**

## TEACHINGS OF JESUS AT THE LAST SUPPER

### John Chapter

- 13            **Serve one another. Jesus humbled Himself and became a servant.**
- 14            **Be encouraged by knowing the conclusion. Let not your heart be troubled...**
- 15            **Jesus said, "Without Me you can do nothing." Abide in Christ.**
- 16            **Yield to the ministry of the Holy Spirit.**
- 17            **Jesus Praying.**

**Matthew 26:26-27 Jesus used the bread (broken) and the cup (poured out) to declare His death as an offering that would take away the sin of the world.**

## TEACHINGS OF JESUS AT THE CROSS

**(1) God is love. Romans 5:8**

**(2) Sin is the atrocious evil which is always against God and life and love. Sin is condemned. Rom. 8:3**

**All through our lives God is demonstrating to us that sin is atrocious. But we can't believe it when it is our sin. The cross proved that sin is atrocious. Sin killed the sinless, holy Son of God.**

**By the cross, sin is condemned and sentenced to removal from all creation. By believing in Jesus for sin removal individuals are made new creations in Christ.**
