

WHY JESUS DIED AND ROSE AGAIN FROM THE GRAVE

The Eternal Son of God became the perfect human without a sin nature.

Being the perfect man, Jesus lived sinless and died sinless.

Sin condemned itself and sentenced itself to extinction when sin killed the perfect, innocent, and sinless Jesus.

God the Father raised Jesus from the grave and gave Him authority and power to judge all things and ultimately remove all sin and death from creation. We are saved by His resurrection life. Rom. 5:10

The Man, Jesus, felt God the Father hold back His hand of protection. The Man, Jesus, felt Himself swallowed up in physical death. But Jesus maintained faith in God the Father that this mission of death would be victorious over sin and death. Jesus said, "Father into Thy hand I commit My spirit." God the Father watched meticulously over Jesus so that not one bone of His body was broken.

"Jesus bore our sins" means that Jesus took our abuse toward Him, suffered our abuse, and never sinned, so that we may believe in Him, die to sins, and live for righteousness. 1 Peter 2:24

"Jesus bore our sins" does not mean that God the Father punished Jesus in our place.

"Jesus bore our sins" does not mean that God the Father poured out His wrath on His Son.

God the Father does not need to be appeased of His wrath against us by killing His Son.

God has no need to change. We must be changed and made into new creations.
