

THE TRUE MEANING OF: JESUS DIED FOR OUR SINS

JESUS BORE OUR SINS ON THE CROSS

THE LORD LAID ON JESUS THE INIQUITY OF US ALL

Isaiah 53:6 “the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.” The true meaning of this passage is that God allowed sin to abuse and kill the physical body of Jesus. And since Jesus was sinless, all sin is condemned to the utmost by the atrocious deed. The suffering of His soul while on the Cross was having been given the knowledge of all sin being thrust upon His conscious mind and body. By His knowledge of our sin and His suffering thereof, Jesus died a sinless death which defeated sin and Satan and by His resurrection brings justification of life to all who believe and receive Him as Lord. Isaiah 53:10-11

1 Peter 2:24 “He Himself bore our sins in His body on the tree.” The true meaning of this passage is that God allowed Jesus to be abused and killed by the sin of humanity. God even orchestrated the Cross, allowing it to happen, for the purpose of redemption.

Jesus died for our sins.

Jesus died so that He would have the right to remove us from our sin.

Jesus died so that He would have the right to do righteous acts in us that have eternal value.

Jesus did one act of righteousness which provided justification for Him giving us eternal life.

That one act was sinless death. Romans 5:18-19

On the cross, the full force of sin struck against Jesus and killed His physical body.

Sin broke God’s Law of Sin and Death. Genesis 2:17 “IF YOU SIN YOU DIE.”

Jesus never sinned. God said that sin is condemned because it brought death to the sinless Man. Romans 8:3 Sin is sentenced to removal from all Creation. Rev. 20,21,22

God raised Jesus to be Judge over all Creation. John 5:22 Jesus will remove all sin.
