

## **JESUS DID ONE ACT OF RIGHTEOUSNESS TO REVERSE ALL THAT ADAM LOST**

Therefore as through one man's offense judgment came to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act the free gift came to all men, resulting in justification of life. Romans 5:18

Jesus became flesh so that by His death He could destroy the devil. Heb. 2:14

Jesus canceled the governing power of the law of sin and death by His death on the cross. Colossians 2:14

Through Christ Jesus, the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death. Romans 8:2

Jesus disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame by triumphing over them at the cross. Colossians 2:15
