**Don't think that your sin is hidden from God.**

**God sees your sin. Sin will hurt you.**

**If you think Jesus has hidden your sin from God, you will stop repenting.**

**Repenting daily means you allow the Holy Spirit to convict you of sin and you cooperate with the Spirit to remove sin from your life.**

**Hebrews 12:5-11**

**"My child, don't ignore it when the Lord disciplines you, and don't be discouraged when He corrects you. For the Lord disciplines those He loves, and He chastises those He accepts as His children." As you endure this divine discipline, remember that God is treating you as His own children. Whoever heard of a child who was never disciplined? If God doesn't discipline you as He does all of His children it means that you are not really His child at all. God's discipline is always right and good for us because it means we will share in His holiness. No discipline is enjoyable while it is happening, it is painful! But afterward there will be a quiet harvest of right living for those who are trained in this way.**

**Don't excuse your sin. Some think their sin is just human and cannot be helped.**

**Don't think there is no way to stop sinning. Colossians 3:1-25**

**Put to death the sinful, earthly things lurking within you. Get rid of anger, rage, malicious behavior, slander, and dirty language. Put on tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. Forgive each other just as God forgave you. Love each other. Let the words of Christ live in your hearts and make you wise. Whatever you do or say, let it represent the Lord Jesus. Be thankful to God.**

**Don't think that you cannot do righteous acts. All Holy Spirit empowered acts in your life go with you to Heaven. Revelation 19:8**

**God loves you so much He will not leave you unchanged. Philippians 1:6,9-11**

**Don't ignore it when the Lord disciplines you. Don't be discouraged when being disciplined.**

**God disciplines you because He loves you and you are His child.**

**God hates sin because sin hurts you. God's change for you is always right and good.**

**God sees your future. God sees you glorified, sinless, and totally righteous. God will complete the work He began in you. God sees the end as well as the beginning.**
