

THE WAY TO ETERNAL LIFE

Jesus lived sinless in human flesh, died sinless, and arose the third day just as He said He would.

You were redeemed with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect.

1 Peter 1:19

We are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and the teachers of the law. They will condemn Him to death and will turn Him over to the Gentiles to be mocked and flogged and crucified. On the third day He will be raised to life! Matthew 20:18,19

Because sin killed Jesus and Jesus died sinless, sin is condemned to removal from creation, and Jesus arose with all power and authority to remove sin from all who trust in Him. Sin removal is a process and includes physical death to complete.

For what the law was powerless to do in that it was weakened by the sinful nature, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful man to be a sin offering. And so God's condemnation of sin was accomplished through the sinless crucified flesh of Jesus, in order that the righteous requirements of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the sinful nature but according to the Spirit. All people who believe in Jesus for personal sin removal are born of the Spirit. You must be born again in order to be saved from sin. Galatians 5:22-26 The fruits of the Spirit are produced in me. The born again believer is declared righteous by faith in Jesus and he lives by faith in Jesus.
