God sent His Son to earth through a process of becoming a man, dying, and resurrection. This process enables Jesus to save repentant sinners from their sin. This process is orderly, God-given, and proven to be just in the Court of Heaven.

The process is orderly and God-given:

It was pre planned before creation. 1 Peter 1:20,21 John 1:29

Jesus was chosen before creation to be the sinless Lamb who takes away the sin of the world.

Jesus was made flesh through virgin birth and without a sin nature. Luke 1:35

Jesus is God and is therefore perfect as God is perfect. Hebrews 1:8-13

Jesus was tested, even by Satan, and yet remained sinless and died sinless. 1 Peter 2:21-23

Jesus was unjustly condemned in the courts of man and was nailed to a cross to die.

Jesus was God, yet all sin was thrust upon Him because sin is always against God. 1 Peter 2:24

Jesus gave Himself to die a physical death in order to condemn sin to its ultimate destruction.

Romans 8:3

God the Father loves the world so much that He was pleased for His Son to be bruised for the purpose of removing sin, death, and all wickedness from creation. Colossians 1:19,20 Ephesians 5:2

The unjust physical death of sinless Jesus and His bodily resurrection propelled Him to the status of Last Adam. Jesus is humanity's God given substitute for Adam, representative for humanity.

Romans 5:18,19

As victorious Last Adam, Jesus has the right to remove all sin and death from creation. All judgment is given to the Son of God by God the Father. John 5:22,23

All authority is given to Jesus. Matthew 28:18

Through Jesus, this substitute representative, all humanity has provisional reconciliation with God and opportunity for new life in Christ. 2 Corinthians 5:19

Born again believers have judicial reconciliation and release from bondage to sin. Jesus has become their new Adam. Romans 5:9,10

Jesus is the Way that born again believers live a new life in Christ. They have died to their sole relationship to Adam. They have a new relationship with Jesus Christ. Romans chapters 6,7,8

Sin in the believer is being taken away. 1 John 1:9,10

Salvation is a process of justification, sanctification, and glorification.

Jesus does righteous actions within the believer through the power of the Spirit.
