

JESUS WILL REMOVE THE LAW OF SIN AND DEATH FROM ALL CREATION

The law of sin and death is that all of creation is subject to death because of the sin of Adam. The law of sin and death is the governance of the written code, ordinance, and decree which is against humanity because all have sinned and come short of the glory of God. Man was made to be the image bearer of the glory of God. Redeemed people are restored to being image bearers of the glory of God.

THE WRITTEN DECREE WAS NAILED TO THE CROSS Colossians 2:14

Jesus nailed the written code, ordinance, and decree to the cross, which means that Jesus procured the eventual removal of all sin and death from creation. Jesus procured the removal of the law of sin and death from the believing, cooperating individual born into Christ and not born solely in Adam. The sinner who cooperates with Holy Spirit conviction and allows the Spirit to bring him to saving faith in Jesus is given eternal life at the moment of new birth in Christ. Jesus is the resurrection and the life to all those who believe in Him. The new creation in Christ is born into a right relationship with God. By nailing the written decree to the cross, Jesus became humanity's God-given substitute for Adam and gained the Way for man to be changed through new birth, sanctification, and ultimately glorification.

God's program for removing the governance of the law of sin and death over creation is first by building His church, second by worldwide judgment with a redemptive purpose, third by the millennial rule of Christ on earth, fourth by final judgment, and fifth by creating a new heaven and new earth.

Jesus did one act of righteousness on the cross and that act was to die sinless. By dying sinless, Jesus condemned sin to the utmost, sentencing sin to execution, extermination, and extinction. Jesus, the Second Adam, arose with all power and authority to remove sin. Today, Jesus is removing sin from all who are made new creations in Christ.

THE SIMPLICITY OF THE GOSPEL OF JESUS CHRIST

Jesus died to take away our sin.

Jesus arose to give us new life in Him.

The Holy Spirit leads to salvation whoever has a readiness of mind to believe.

All who believe in Jesus will be saved.

Born again believers can never be taken out of the Father's hand.

Systematic Theologies add volumes of teachings which are not found in the Bible. The extra-biblical volumes of their teachings make their leaders feel elite, authoritative, powerful, and worthy of great compensation. Most believers just have their Bibles, they see the simplicity of the gospel, and they are astonished at the teachings of the elite. If a person was not taught systematic theologies, he would never find those false teachings in the Bible. These teachings try to apply the ways of men to the ways of God. "My thoughts are not your thoughts, and my ways are not your ways," declares the LORD.

The following are what the Bible declares, in comparison to what Systematic Theologies declare.

THE DECREE NAILED TO THE CROSS OF JESUS Colossians 2:14

The written decree which Jesus nailed to the cross was the law of sin and death, not a certificate of the sin debt paid by Jesus. Jesus was not paying a debt, but paying the price for sin's condemnation and removal from creation. Sin did the most atrocious thing in killing the Son of God. Matthew 21:33-41

THE REASON JESUS DIED Romans 8:1-4; Ephesians 5:2; Hebrews 10:10-14; Romans 3:21-26

The sinless death of Jesus condemned sin to the utmost and sentenced sin to execution. The resurrected life of Christ gives new life to those who believe in Him. The sinless death of Jesus was not to appease God of His anger, and not to pay our sin debt by being punished by God in our place.

WE DO NOT INHERIT ADAM'S GUILT Matthew 12:31 John 3:18,36

A baby is not a sinner until he sins. A baby is not born guilty. Babies cannot reject the conviction of the Holy Spirit and therefore are not subject to condemnation. Babies are safe in Jesus. A baby's nature is not guilty until he sins against the Holy Spirit. Many teach the opposite.

THE JUSTICE AND RIGHTEOUSNESS OF GOD 2 Corinthians 5:17 Philippians 1:6 Colossians 2:10

God's remedy for our brokenness is to make all repentant persons, who allow themselves to be led to saving faith in Jesus, into new creations. God is able and willing to keep His promise to complete the work He began and therefore new creations enter heaven totally sinless and totally righteous. By changing the sinner to the glorified state, God is justified in giving him eternal life. Some teach that God changes Himself and reconciles Himself to believers by killing Jesus in our place. Instead, the Bible says that God reconciles the repentant sinner to Himself. God does not change. God doesn't need to be reconciled to us. We need to be reconciled to God.

MAN'S ABILITY TO RESPOND TO GOD

All men have the ability to respond to God and cooperate with Holy Spirit conviction. John 16:7,8
Some teach that man is so spiritually dead that he cannot respond to God in any way.

THE CONDITION UPON MAN FOR RECEIVING ETERNAL LIFE Romans 5 and 8 John 1,2,3 "believe"

A person must cooperate with Holy Spirit conviction and allow the Spirit to bring him to saving faith in Jesus. Some teach unconditional election under a false definition of election.

THE EXTENT OF THE POWER OF THE CROSS OF JESUS 1 Timothy 4:10

The death of Jesus was for the whole of creation. Jesus died to save whosoever will believe in Him. Jesus died to redeem all of creation from sin and death. Jesus died for all people, but only those who meet the condition will have eternal life. Some teach of a limited effectiveness of His death toward only the elect (a false definition of election).

There is to come, a glorious removal of the law of sin and death from all creation.

ETERNAL SECURITY OF THE BELIEVER John 3:3 1 John 5:13

Once a repentant sinner is born into the family of God, he cannot be unborn. Eternal security is in the fact that God promises to complete the work He began in the born again believer. Some teach that only the truly elect of God (elect before creation) will be saved, so their faith is in their election. They have a false definition of election.

Some teach that a born again believer can fall from grace and return to an unsaved condition.

Western civilization has made the gospel of Jesus Christ into a religious tax code which is corrupted and detrimental to all people. The religious tax code says that God must be reconciled to man. Corrupted leaders of the religious tax code gain power over the masses because they have a systematic theology that is written outside of the Holy Scriptures and only these elite teachers and leaders have access to the voluminous code.

The simplicity of the gospel of Jesus Christ is found in Holy Scripture. The religious tax code is a Satanic Deception worthy of a powerful adversary to the gospel.

God does not change. God has always been just, righteous, and love. God has no need to be reconciled to man. Holy Scripture only advocates that man must be reconciled to God. The cross of Jesus brings that reconciliation of man back to God. The cross condemns sin to removal from creation and gains the Man, Jesus Christ, the right of all judgment and sin removal. Meeting the condition for eternal life, an individual is changed into a new creation in Christ Jesus. The new creation in Christ is freed from the penalty of sin, moved out from under the wrath of God, and free to walk in the newness of life in the power of the Holy Spirit. Being a new creation is the reason God is just and righteous in forgiving all our sin and giving us eternal life. God is not bound by time. He sees the new creation in Christ as already complete in Christ.

Colossians 2:9-10

9 For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; 10 and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.
